The letter will acknowledge, and seek the continuance of, Ralphs promised to install a parking lot security camera and assign two security guards before the end of May. Ralphs stated the store is owned by the landlord so both entities share the responsibility of providing a safe environment to the public, both while shopping and on the premises, including the parking lot and other businesses. The crafting of the letter by the CNC was endorsed by LAPD Captain Burns, commanding officer Devonshire Division, when discussed at an earlier meeting, if the board so chooses to approve.
