David Meza S. Cal Gas Co update

State granted permission to reinject gas at Aliso Canyon. Will take some time, one of the steps before reopening. Limited capacity and won't use all the wells. Operating at reduced pressure. Has been approved and inspected by the state by a rigorous process. Replaced inner workings. David will be engaged with the community, and will continue to attend CNC meetings. 811 – Free nationwide service by utilities, asking people to call before digging for construction to show where lines are. This month is 811 month.

Community member question: Why won't S Cal Gas release what chemicals are involved? They have been asked. And what is contingency plan?

David – I'm not familiar with that request. County may have that information. I will get that info. Several groups have to work together to develop a plan.

Community member – Can you update us on the status of the compressor upgrade? David - Turbine replacement project – currently giant turbines compress the gas to store it. 3-4 years ago got approval and started construction. Now in final stages. Haven't utilized new turbines yet. Started operations on Monday. Website with info.

Mitch Englander – Thanking CNC. Emergency Contingency plan answer: Urged LAFD and others to develop emergency plan. County Fire Chief does not support the reopening of Aliso Canyon Gas Facility. Plans will be reviewed. Fire Dept has authority to approve anything above ground, and below ground belongs to the state. There have been no reviewed plans yet. Separate topic – Red curb painting on Oakdale was a rogue operation, not city approved. Being investigated as a felony. A dangerous paint was used; slippery when wet. Gray temporary paint. Have to sandblast it off, and then repaint. Paint itself is \$3,000. The issue is why the curb was painted. Homelessness is growing exponentially. Drug & Alc, aggressive panhandlers. One reason it is growing in this area because... (City can't store homeless belongings) ...until there is enough housing, court says that this kind of living has to be allowed. Chatsworth has the largest industrial area in LA, which flags it as available. New initiative: Neighborhoods First. Working with LAPD Hope Teams, and faith based.... Looking to include CNC and nonprofits. San Fernando Rescue Mission is helping families succeed. Also purchasing mobile showers. There is a Homeless Ombudsman. Clean up efforts are being coordinated for Chatsworth Park North. **Will need approval for more housing from CNC.**

Andre – CNC has been fortunate to have access to Councilmember. But the homeless issue is at a low point. All I ask is coordination with the clean-ups.

Linda – Towing of RV question – we are paying for these contracts? Can you scrap them?

Mitch – yes. First thing was getting them off the street. One of my colleagues suggests that we clean their septic for free, if the person is prequalified.

Community Member – I live by Chatsworth Park North. These people are destroying my property value. How do we get someone for these people to check on them.

Mitch – The hot spots is a place where they congregate, and we are putting teams there. Community Member – Who would I call?

Mitch- We're putting a sheet together. It's not just one point of contact. Getting a MEU for triage.

Community Member – We've been submitting requests to your office about Chatsworth Park North. In recent past, LAPD has been in there numerous times. Who is coordinating the volunteers for Chatsworth Park north?

Mitch – Day of Clean up for when the heat dies down, in September. Will get you that info. Community Member – Who do we call to volunteer?

Mitch – anyone in my office, and sign up for newsletter.

Community Member – After WWII soldiers were returning to a depression, and they weren't going to be enough houses. But then there was the GI bill. The govt would guarantee the loan. Mitch – we hired transients to clean the streets and offered grocery gift cards, and got sober. Partnered with SFVRM.

Jeff- How much more support are police officers getting?

Mitch – how are we getting more officers out from behind a desk? No hiring more officers. We need more civilians. So we free up the officers.

Glenn Baily - Overview of voting process.
